DEFINITIONS

Fall In, Place, Position, and Rank

1. **FALL IN:** means takes one place in line or formation.
2. **PLACE:** put in a particular position, point in space, designed for, being used by someone.
3. **POSITION:** a place where someone or something is located, or has been put, a particular way in which someone or something is placed, or arranged, a person's rank, or social standing.
4. **RANK:** a social or official position or standing as in the Armed Forces, to arrange in ranks, or in regular formation, to assign to a particular position, station to form rank or ranks, to take us or occupy a place in a particular rank.

IDIOMS for Rank

1. **BREAK RANKS:** to leave an assigned position in a military formation.
2. **PULL RANK:** to make use of one's superior rank to gain an advantage over someone else.
