## DEFINITIONS

---

**Surrender** is a military term meaning to acknowledge a greater power or force, Deity, or to an Army which has the greatest advantage, and you cannot win. To surrender wave the white flag, to give up, to stop fighting, to quit.

**Obedience is** compliance with an order, request, or law or submission to another's authority.

**Biblical obedience to God** means to hear, trust, submit and surrender to **God** and his Word.
